- Laundry detergent



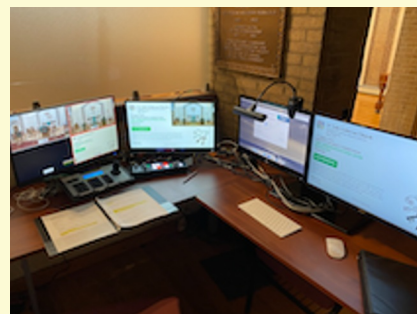

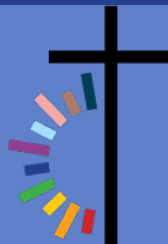
